


ROAD TRAFFIC

The Road Sensors Speed Measuring and the Light Signals (Detection of Offences) Devices Approval 2013

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 20(4) and (5) of the Road Traffic Offenders Act 1988(a) (Speeding offences etc: admissibility of certain evidence), and having prescribed for the purposes of section 20 of that Act a device:

- (i) designed or adapted for recording a measurement of the speed of motor vehicles activated by means of sensors embedded below the road surface (b), and
- (ii) designed or adapted for recording by photographic or other image recording means the position of motor vehicles in relation to light signals (c),

approves as from 30 September 2013 for the purpose of detection of offences specified in section 20(2)(a), (b), (c), (d) or (e) the type of such devices known as the **REDFLEXspeed speed measurement enforcement device**, **REDFLEXred red traffic light enforcement device** and the **REDFLEXred-speed speed measurement enforcement and red traffic light enforcement device** manufactured by **REDFLEX Traffic Systems Pty Limited, South Melbourne, Victoria, Australia.**

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Approval)

Section 20 of the Road Traffic Offenders Act 1988 (as amended) (the "1988 Act") provides for the admissibility in evidence of records from prescribed devices. Such devices must be of a description prescribed by the Secretary of State and of a type approved by her for the purpose of that section. By the Road Traffic Offenders (Prescribed Devices) Order 1993 (S.I.1993/1698) and the Road Traffic Offenders (Prescribed Devices) Order 1992 (S.I.1992/2843), the Secretary of State prescribed devices designed or adapted for recording a measurement of the speed of motor vehicles by capturing by means of unattended camera images the motor vehicle at each of two pre-determined positions on the road, digitally recording each image and the time it is captured and calculating the average speed of the motor vehicle over the distance between the two positions. This approval approves as from 30 September 2013 for the purpose of the detection of those speeding offences listed in section 20(2) (a), (b), (c), (d) or (e) of the 1988 Act the type of devices known as the **REDFLEX speed speed measurement enforcement device . REDFLEX red red traffic light enforcement device and the REDFLEX red-speed speed measurement enforcement and red traffic light enforcement device** manufactured by **REDFLEX Traffic Systems Pty Limited, South Melbourne, Victoria, Australia**
